

The Family Birthing Suites' C-Section Suite has arrived, bringing a fresh modern space located just steps from the labor and delivery suites. The newly expanded C-Section Suite delivers an operating room, a stream-lined layout, enhanced functionality, and upgraded equipment within a dedicated operating room for mother and baby.

In partnership with area donors, UnityPoint Health - Finley Health Foundation was able to fund the \$1.4 million renovation. "Generous support of area individuals, families, grants and corporate gifts enabled us to secure the funding to ensure we can be ready to serve families in the tri-state area well into the future," says Barbara Potts, Executive Director of the Foundation, "both Finley Hospital and the Finley Health Foundation would like to express our gratitude to everyone who made the renovation possible."

With 578 births in 2025, Finley Hospital is not just a hospital, it is a preferred choice for families.

"Providing an exceptional birthing experience is our goal for mother and baby. Innovative technology can play a significant role in that experience. A baby monitoring system now provides line of sight to the baby warmer in the suite. If the baby is not on the mother's chest, she will have a monitor right above her head for a full view, to assist in the crucial bonding experience at birth." 

MIRACLES ON THE MISSISSIPPI



The 2025 Miracles on the Mississippi, held on Saturday, August 16, was a fantastic evening featuring delicious hors d'oeuvres, unique live auction packages and country newcomers, The Castellows.

Miracles on the Mississippi kicked off the Images Through Innovation Campaign to upgrade and enhance imaging equipment and services at UnityPoint Health - Finley Hospital.

Radiologist, Dr. Nicholas Stabo, and Charlye Jenkins, Finley's Hospital's Radiology Manager, shared with guests the importance of enhanced technology and early detection in breast cancer. Charlye shared the story of Grace; a cancer patient who once believed her risk was so low that she delayed her routine screenings because she had no family history and lived a healthy, active lifestyle. Grace's story is a powerful and deeply personal reminder that breast cancer doesn't always follow the rules or wait until later in life. Her diagnosis underscores the critical importance of early detection—how it can truly save lives, even for those who never imagined they were at risk.

Dr. Stabo shared that as a radiologist, his work is deeply connected to technology. The ability to provide exceptional care to patients hinges not only on his expertise and experience, but also on the advanced tools he uses. Investing in state-of-the-art mammography technology provides dramatically clearer imaging, allowing radiologists to better distinguish between potential risks and mere artifacts—leading to more accurate diagnoses.

The Images Through Innovation Campaign will provide Finley Hospital's Radiology Department with advanced 3D mammography and stereotactic breast biopsy equipment—cutting-edge technologies that enable earlier detection, greater accuracy, a more comfortable experience, and improved outcomes for patients facing breast health concerns.

Public Health Impacts Us All

The UnityPoint Health – Dubuque Visiting Nurse Association (VNA) has worked collaboratively since 1910 to offer an array of public health services. While known for the work they do to ensure infants and children are properly vaccinated, VNA must stay nimble and adapt to the changing needs of the community. Support from grants, donations, and partnerships help to ensure these services are available to all who need them.

VNA offers WIC services, lead testing for children birth to 5 years old, child health case management and coordination, presumptive eligibility Medicaid applications, services to elderly and disabled, immunizations, and so much more.

This year gifts from the Sisters of Charity of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Sisters of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, helped to make the culturally congruent doula program possible. Doulas from diverse cultures are one way to ensure that expectant mothers get the prenatal care they need, helping to build trust and ease barriers to care. While some counties in Iowa are maternal health deserts, the VNA helps by providing culturally congruent doulas, Title V family planning services, and support for expectant mothers, infants, and families.

In 2025, the culturally congruent doula program supported community members to become DONA Doula certified. This included two Spanish bilingual individuals, one Spanish/ K'iche trilingual individual, two Black/African American individuals, and one Marshallese bilingual individual. Together, these Doulas served 15 pregnant women for prenatal, birth, and post-partum support services.

The Leitch Family moved to Dubuque and wanted to give back to the Dubuque community that was good to them—they made life-long friends and found ways to deepen their community connections through volunteer service and philanthropy.

Chad shared that for his family, philanthropy was “part of our anatomy,” giving back and helping others was taught to them through their parents. Rita grew up on a farm and shares that her parents were always helping others, so finding ways to continue that legacy was natural for them.

Chad has been a member of the Thompson and Associates Values-Based Estate Planning team for eighteen years and has found that many people, “don’t understand the power of the philanthropic dollar.” When asked what advice Chad has for others as they begin to consider the legacy they want to leave, he shared that “you don’t know what you don’t know.” By engaging a philanthropic advisor, such as Thompson and Associates, you can find ways to take care of your family and divert taxes to meet your charitable goals.


Through their estate plan and the tool known as a charitable remainder unitrust, Chad and Rita have ensured that their daughter, Heather, is taken care of, memorialized their son, Adam, and met the charitable goals they set for themselves.

Along with their parents, Chad shares that he had many people in his life who inspired generosity and service to others. When he first began practicing law in Dubuque, the law firm strongly encouraged their team to volunteer. Chad quickly became involved with UnityPoint Health-Finley Hospital, serving many years on both the Finley Health Foundation board and the Finley Hospital board beginning in the late 1980’s.

When asked why they choose to support healthcare philanthropy, they shared that they feel it has the greatest impact on people and the community. “There is something about helping people who are sick get well and stay well.” It is critical to them that the local community continue to have options for healthcare right in their hometown. They understand how taxing it can be on people to have to travel out of town for services. They praise Finley Hospital for continuing to advance technology and recruit skilled providers, in addition to having what Chad and Rita say is “the most caring team.” They understand philanthropy can help ensure the hospital has the latest technology and exceptional care locally.

Chad shared that through his work on the boards, he understands the challenges hospitals face with low operating margins and believes philanthropy is an important part of keeping treatment and care local. Philanthropy makes the difference for hospitals facing these challenges and making things like purchasing equipment possible. Chad and Rita have a palpable reverence for the entire team and have known numerous people who received exceptional care through oncology and cardiology services.

Though the Leitch family moved out of Iowa, they remain dedicated members of the Finley Health Foundation Legacy Society and encourage others to consider the impact they can make through legacy giving.

Poppy has graciously served on the UnityPoint Health - Finley Health Foundation Board of Directors since 2019, completing her term as board chair in 2025. As she enters her final year on the Foundation Board, she is now serving on the Finley Hospital and UnityPoint Health System Board of Directors. She and husband, Jason Benson, Global IT Infrastructure Manager for Kearney Consulting, share in their commitment to giving back to the community. They support several nonprofit organizations through their time, skills, and philanthropic support.

Poppy and Jason moved back to Dubuque 10 years ago and share their home with their standard poodle, Mick, and rescue toy poodle, Ruby. When not busy volunteering for the causes close to her heart, Poppy can be found enjoying a novel, on the golf course—which she says is a good excuse to be outside -- or traveling with her family. She and Jason loved visiting Italy in the off-season for a quieter adventure. Along her travels, she likes to pick up new spices to recreate foods she tries.

“Serving on the foundation board allows me to steward community generosity with accountability and purpose, helping turn donor intent into measurable impact.” says Poppy. She understands that philanthropy is an essential component to Finley Hospital’s ability to continue to innovate and meet the healthcare needs of the region.

“One hope that Jason and I have for our community is that everyone, regardless of background or circumstance, has real access to opportunity, whether that’s quality education, access to the arts, or pathways to meaningful work. Philanthropy plays a critical role in making that hope possible. It allows us to invest

where systems fall short, to innovate, and to respond with compassion and flexibility. Beyond funding programs, philanthropy builds connections. It brings people together around shared values and a collective responsibility for one another. At its best, it doesn’t just address immediate needs; it helps create lasting change by strengthening the fabric of the community itself.” says Poppy.

She credits her family for teaching her about the priority of giving back by donating time and resources to help the community thrive. Through her tenure at Conlon Construction, this belief has been strengthened, and she continues to find ways to expand her ability to help others. She shared that the company “has an amazing group of generous and dedicated employees who live up to Conlon’s commitment to giving back. Conlon Construction and their employees support dozens of nonprofit organizations each year by giving of their time, talents of their team, and philanthropic donations.”

Jason added, “Community healthcare should be a foundational pillar of any philanthropic plan, because people must have their physical and mental health needs met before they can pursue other opportunities in their lives. 

During Poppy’s tenure on the Foundation board, many projects were made possible through the generosity of donors, but one of the projects she recalls being most impacted by was the expansion of the UnityPoint Health Pediatric Rehabilitation Center. She says, “Seeing the center come to fruition was amazing. Not only did the kids have more space and better equipment, but the staff is now able to serve additional children who need their care. Hearing the stories of people whose lives have been touched by the enhancements we are able to provide through the Foundation never gets old.”
