2022-2024 Plan Impact

Strategic Priority: Access to Healthcare

Actions:

1. **Complete:** UPH VNA increased total services by 27% including a 33% increase in direct clinical Care
2. **Complete:** UPH VNA expanded to include Family Planning Services in Northeast Iowa, increasing both services and providers.
3. **Complete:** Expanded reach of EPIC to include public health services
4. **Complete:** Continued to expand and improve telehealth services to expand to new locations including UPH VNA West



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Strategic Priority: Obesity

Actions:

1. **Complete:** UPH Finley continued involvement of Dubuque County Wellness Coalition to include multiple department involvement and VNA co-lead.
2. **Complete:** UPH VNA continued providing SNAP enrollment signups. 4 enrollment events were completed.
3. **Complete:** UPH Finley continues to support employee health and benefits with OnPoint for Health. Includes wellness credits for annual physicals, participate in wellness challenges for point credits, and opportunities for increased education.

Strategic Priority: Brain Health

Actions

1. **Complete:** UPH Finley continued to support UPH EAP program with promotion, increased access, and additional coverage.
2. **Complete:** UPH Finley continues to actively engage in community activities by actively participating in NAMI and Mental Health Awareness.
3. **Complete:** UPH Finley has implemented and continued to support Adult Intensive Outpatient Program for individuals, groups, and family therapy and medication reviews.
4. **Not Complete:** UPH Finley will have focus groups to support the community effort of Brain health instead of mental illness and end the stigma for treatment

Actions:

NAMI/Mental Health America

Adult intensive Outpatient Program-18+ group, individual, and family therapy and medication review.



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
