- Iowa Methodist Medical Center was re-verified as a Level 1 Adult Trauma Center, a testament to the high-quality emergency and trauma care provided.

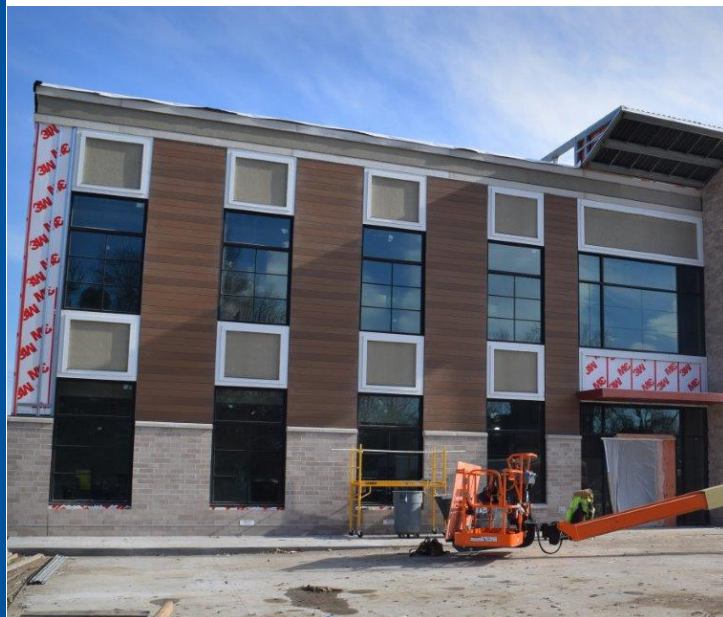
## One Place for Care – The Future of Mental Health Care

### Cardiac Care

Our Electrophysiologists were some of the first in the nation to use a new pulsed field ablation system to treat AFib, which is one of the most treated heart rhythm disorders in the United States.

### Dorner-Villeneuve Simulation Education Center

Purchase new video and audio equipment for every training room helping further educate our future nurses and doctors.

### Nurse Education

More than 200 nurses advance their education and practice through continuing education, certifications and conference attendance.

### Behavioral Health

Provide 100 hours of music therapy for inpatients as well as art therapy supplies for pediatric, adult and geriatric behavioral health patients. In addition, five iPads were purchased for Eyerly Ball's FACT and ACT teams, which greatly improved community-based in-home care visits.

### Taylor House Hospice & UnityPoint at Home

Taylor House updated their therapeutic tub, offering physical relief as well as peace and comfort for patients experiencing end-of-life care.

### Elder Care

A Virtual Dementia Tour was created to help better a dementia patient's experience while receiving care in the hospital.
