## MIRACLES MISSISSIPPI







The 2025 Miracles on the Mississippi, held on Saturday, August 16, was a fantastic evening featuring delicious hors d'oeuvres, unique live auction packages and country newcomers, The Castellows.

Miracles on the Mississippi kicked off the Images Through Innovation Campaign to upgrade and enhance imaging equipment and services at UnityPoint Health - Finley Hospital.

Finley Hospital's Dr. Nicholas Stabo, Chief Radiologist, and Charlye Jenkins, Radiology Manager, shared with guests the importance of enhanced technology and early detection in breast cancer. Charlye shared the story of Grace; a cancer patient who once believed her risk was so low that she delayed her routine screenings because she had no family history and lived a healthy, active lifestyle. Grace's story is a powerful and deeply personal reminder that breast cancer doesn't always follow the rules or wait until later in life. Her diagnosis underscores the critical importance of early detection—how it can truly save lives, even for those who never imagined they were at risk.

Dr. Stabo shared that as a radiologist, his work is deeply connected to technology. The ability to provide exceptional care to patients hinges not only on his expertise and experience, but also on the advanced tools he uses. Investing in state-of-the-art mammography technology provides dramatically clearer imaging, allowing radiologists to better distinguish between potential risks and mere artifacts—leading to more accurate diagnoses.

This year's event netted more than \$140,000 to support the Images Through Innovation Campaign at Finley Hospital.

#### Finley Hospital Debuts New MRI Scanner

UnityPoint Health - Finley Hospital began seeing patients with its new Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scanner earlier this year, offering patients a more comfortable experience and quicker scan times.

The Siemens Magnetom Biomatrix Altea reduces scan times by 51 percent and features a wider opening and QUIET Suite imaging technology, which lowers sound pressure levels by at least 70 percent, helping to reduce anxiety and claustrophobia patients may experience.

MRI scanners use magnets and radio waves to generate detailed images of soft tissues like muscles, ligaments, and the brain. The new machine offers technology that reduces the distortion from MRI-safe implants as well as motion correction to further enhance image quality. The new scanner also has an increased weight limit of 550 pounds.

#### Consider a Charitable Gift Before Year-End

As the end of 2025 draws near, consider making an impact for your community with a charitable year-end gift. Your support can be through UnityPoint Health - Finley Health Foundation to support UnityPoint Health - Finley Hospital or the Dubuque Visiting Nurse Association.

Did you know there are a variety of ways to give support in addition to the traditional gifts of cash, check, or via credit card? Donating stock or making an IRA charitable rollover can be a quick and straightforward way to show your generosity.

Donating appreciated stock allows you to save on your taxes in two different ways: you avoid capital gains tax on the stock value, and you can claim a tax-deduction on the value of the shares you donate.

For those 70 ½ years of age and older, an IRA charitable rollover, or qualified charitable distribution (QCD), may be a better option for you. A QCD allows you to transfer up to \$100,000 per year directly to the Finley Health Foundation.

A benefit to transferring gifts from a QCD ensures you don't have to count the transfers as income for federal income tax purposes and transfers may satisfy your required minimum distribution (RMD). If you have retirement assets in a 401k, 403b, or like accounts, you must first roll those funds into an IRA.



To donate stock or make a qualified distribution from your IRA to the Finley Health Foundation, simply reach out to your brokerage firm or IRA administrator to initiate a transfer.
