

NURSE RESIDENCY PATIENT CARE AREAS

Iowa Methodist Medical Center

Emergency Department

Fast paced Level 1 Trauma Center and Primary Stroke Center. Providing care to patients experiencing emergent illness, injury, and acute care illness for patients 18 years and older.

Surgery

Provide care for patients of all ages undergoing surgical procedures at a level 1 trauma center. Collaborate with the surgical team to ensure safe surgical procedures and patient care outcomes. Surgical specialties include neurosurgery, cardiac, orthopedics, general surgery, bariatrics, ENT, gynecology, urology transplants and robotics. Extensive training provided.

Adult Critical Care (36-bed unit)

Caring for critically ill adult patients with various diagnoses including but not limited to trauma, neurology, medical, surgical, pulmonary, and cardiovascular surgeries. This mixed critical care unit allows nurses to care for a variety of patients with various needed interventions and closely collaborate with the critical care team and other specialties.

North 3 – Telemetry - 24-bed unit

Caring for patients recovering from cardiac surgeries and procedures including cardiothoracic, cardiovascular surgery, electrophysiology procedures, and percutaneous transluminal coronary angioplasty (PTCA). Fast paced environment with high acuity patients requiring cardiac care and telemetry monitoring.

North 4 – Telemetry - 23-bed unit

Caring for patients with underlying cardiac medical diagnosis including heart failure, myocardial infarction, dysrhythmias, and post cardiac procedure. In addition, this unit cares for acute care stroke patients requiring telemetry monitoring. Fast paced environment with high acuity patients requiring cardiac care.

North 5 – Acute Care General & Women’s Surgery - 24-bed unit

Caring for patients with acute care surgical needs. Specializing in women’s health, gynecology, breast surgeries including the DIEP flap reconstruction surgery, plastic surgery, ENT, and general surgery. Collaboration with the Physician Surgical Residency Program to ensure the patients receive the best outcomes.

North 6 – Acute Care General Surgery - 25-bed unit

Caring for patients with acute care surgical needs. Specializing in colorectal procedures and bariatric sleeve procedures. The physicians and unit have received designation as a Center of Excellence for Bariatric Surgery. Collaboration with the Physician Surgical Residency Program to ensure the patients receive the best outcomes.

Younker 4 – Acute Rehabilitation - 23-bed unit

Caring for patients who need additional rehabilitation following a stroke, spinal cord trauma, brain injury, amputee, or another debilitating diagnosis. The focus for caring for the patients is collaboration with therapy to promote a successful transition back into the patient’s home setting. This unit has received accreditation for almost 40 years for their high-quality care of patients needing rehabilitation.

Younker 5 – Acute Care Renal/Urology/Transplant - 22-bed unit

Caring for patients with acute medical and surgical diagnoses, specializing in urology, nephrology, and renal transplants as we are Central Iowa’s only certified Kidney Transplant Center. The unit partners with the renal transplant team ensure the patients have the best outcomes.

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Younker 7 – Acute Care Medical - 22-bed unit

Caring for acute care patients with medical diagnoses. Admitted patients experience a wide variety of acute or chronic medical problems including but not limited to sepsis, pulmonary diagnoses, diabetes, heart failure, electrolyte imbalances, etc... The unit partners with the Physician Internal Medicine Residency Program and is on the forefront of many new patient care initiatives. Collaboration, teamwork, and innovation lead the team as we care for our unique patient populations.

Younker 8 – Acute Care Medical/ Pulmonary - 23-bed unit

Caring for a variety of acute care patients, specializing in pulmonary diagnoses, diabetic ketoacidosis, and acute or chronic medical conditions. The unit partners the Physician Internal Medicine Residency Program and is involved in many new patient care initiatives. Collaboration, teamwork, and innovation lead the team as we care for our acute patient populations.

Powell 3 – Acute Care Oncology/Hematology - 28-bed unit

Caring for acute care patients experiencing hematology and oncology conditions, specializing in chemotherapy administration. The unit collaborates closely with the John Stoddard Cancer Center to provide holistic care for patients.

Powell 4 – Acute Care Medical Neuro/Trauma - 19-bed unit

Caring for acute medical neurological patients in a Primary Stroke Center with NIH certified nurses with specialties in stroke and seizure care. The unit includes the designated epilepsy monitoring unit and collaborates with Clinical Nurse Specialist and Stroke Coordinator to achieve best patient outcomes.

Powell 5 – Acute Care Surgical Neuro/Trauma & Orthopedics - 25-bed unit

Caring for patients experiencing acute care following traumas at a Level 1 Trauma Center. Patient care conditions include patients experiencing neurological illness, trauma, high-risk spinal surgery, trauma orthopedic care, and traumatic brain injury.

Powell 6/Younker 6 – Maternity - 42-bed units including OBED beds

Level III Maternity Center and Obstetric Emergency Department caring for women across the spectrum of antepartum, intrapartum, and postpartum stages of pregnancy. Care is focused on the maternal-infant dyad to promote biological, social and psychological relationships. Ability to collaborate with level III NICU if additional newborn support is needed.

Emergency Department

Providing fast paced care to patients experiencing emergent illness, injury, and acute care illness for children and adults, specializing in behavioral health care. Collaborates with chemical dependency team and the behavioral health team to provide high quality behavioral and mental health care in the emergency department.

Surgery

Provide care for patients of all ages undergoing surgical procedures. Collaborates with various members of the surgical team to ensure safe surgical procedures and patient care outcomes. Surgical specialties include orthopedics, general surgery, gynecology, dental, robotics.

CICU - 13-bed unit

Caring for critically ill adult patients with various diagnoses including but not limited to neurology, medical, surgical, pulmonary, and behavioral health. This mixed critical care unit allows nurses to care for a variety of patients with various needed interventions and closely collaborate with the critical care team and other specialties.

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2 North – Surgical - 30-bed unit

Caring for a variety of acute care patients, specializing surgical procedures including orthopedic, colorectal, and gynecological. They also care for patients with various medical diagnoses along with behavioral health patients with acute medical needs.

3 North – Telemetry/Med-Surg - 29-bed unit

Caring for patients with underlying cardiac medical diagnosis including heart failure, myocardial infarction, and post percutaneous transluminal coronary angioplasty patients.

A- East – Child/Adolescent Behavioral Health- 16-bed unit

Caring for children and adolescents requiring inpatient treatment for a variety of behavioral health concerns. Collaboration with behavioral health team members to ensure safe discharge planning, medication adjustments, and assisting patients through acute periods of crisis.

1 East – Adult Behavioral Health - 24-bed unit

Caring for adults requiring inpatient treatment for a variety of behavioral health concerns. Collaboration with various behavioral health team members to ensure safe discharge planning, medication adjustments, and assisting patients through acute periods of crisis.

2 East – Geriatric Neuro Behavioral - 12-bed unit

Caring for older adults requiring inpatient treatment for a variety of behavioral health concerns. Collaboration with various behavioral health team members to ensure safe discharge planning, medication adjustments, and assisting patients through acute periods of crisis.

4 East – Acute Rehab

Caring for patients who need additional rehabilitation following a stroke, spinal cord trauma, brain injury, amputee, or another debilitating diagnosis. The focus for caring for the patients in collaboration with therapy to promote a successful transition back into the patient's home setting.

Emergency Department

Providing fast paced care to patients experiencing emergent illness, injury, and acute care illness for children and adults.

Surgery

Provide care for patients of all ages undergoing surgical procedures. Collaborates with various members of the surgical team to ensure safe surgical procedures and patient care outcomes. Surgical specialties include orthopedics, general surgery, spinal, and robotics.

3 West – Orthopedic - 34-bed unit

Caring for patients who have undergone an orthopedic surgery including a total hip or total knee replacement. Close collaboration with the orthopedic surgeons to provide high quality care.

4 West – Medical/Surgical - 30-bed unit

Caring for patients who have undergone a spinal procedure or general surgical procedure and patients experience acute medical conditions including but limited to sepsis, pulmonary diagnoses, diabetes, heart failure, electrolyte imbalances, etc.

5 West – Maternity Center - 24-bed unit

Level II Maternity Center and Level II Special Care Nursery caring for women and infants across the spectrum of antepartum, intrapartum, and postpartum stages of pregnancy. Care is focused on the maternal-infant dyad to promote biological, social, and psychological

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relationships. Ability to collaborate with level III NICU if additional newborn support is needed.

Blank Children's Hospital

Blank- Neonatal Intensive Care

Caring for critically ill newborns requiring additional support from feeding and growing to life saving measures.

Blank- Pediatric ICU - 12-beds

Caring for critically ill infants, children and adolescents with traumatic injuries, life-threatening illness, or following major surgeries.

Blank 3- General Med/Surg - 27-bed units

23 Private rooms and 4 double rooms

Caring for pediatric patients including post-surgical, GI, and Respiratory illnesses including patients with cystic fibrosis and those recovering from acute trauma.

Blank 4 - Hematology/Oncology - 16-bed units

14 Private rooms and 2 double rooms

Caring for a variety of general pediatric patients. Specializing in pediatric hematology and oncology patient care.

Blank Pediatric Emergency Department

Caring for newborns through adolescents experiencing acute and emergent health care conditions and injuries at a level 2 pediatric trauma center.
