delivering Our future

Your support of the *Delivering Our Future* campaign is making the renovation and expansion of GRMC's obstetrics unit possible. In early 2025, bids were being submitted for this project and construction will begin soon (or may already have begun). The GRMC Foundation is very grateful for our donors who are partnering with us to make this improvement a reality.

Funds for this project are coming from a variety of sources. More than \$866,000 has been donated by individuals and businesses in communities served by GRMC. Those generous donors, as of February 28, 2025, are listed at right. Additionally, the hospital was awarded a \$600,000 Community Facilities Block Grant in December 2023, and a portion of the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 Centers of Excellence Grants for Maternal Health will be used for this project. The GRMC Foundation Board has also designated more than \$600,000 to the project from the GRMC Endowment's 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 spendable distribution. Altogether, nearly \$2.3 million has been committed to the expansion and renovation of our obstetrics unit as of February 28, 2025, bringing us to more than **half** of the projected \$4.09 million cost to bring this multi-phase project to completion.

The GRMC Foundation thanks the donors listed for their support of the *Delivering Our Future* campaign for the OB unit's expansion and renovation.

A Family Tradition



The GRMC Foundation gratefully shines a light on the generosity of the Estate of F. Addison Jones, the F. Austin and Kim Jones family, and Grinnell State Bank. Their support of the *Delivering Our Future* capital campaign to expand and renovate GRMC's obstetrics (OB) unit will impact families in this region for years to come. Thank you!

Grinnell is home to **F. Austin and Kim Jones**, high school sweethearts who recently celebrated their 38th anniversary. They returned to Grinnell after graduating from college to work and ultimately raise their family. Austin and Kim enjoy being grandparents and spending time with their family: daughters Alyson Jones, Kelsey (Nick) McCulley, and Miranda (Kyle) Bradberry, and grandchildren Jaxon McCulley, Emilia McCulley, and Koen Bradberry.

Austin is the President, Chief Financial Officer, and Chief Trust Officer of Grinnell State Bank. In addition to his position at the bank, Austin serves on a variety of nonprofit boards and is a triple-threat athlete who competes in triathlons around the country.

Kim is a nurse at Grinnell Regional Medical Center, where she has worked for 38 years – 34 of those in the obstetrics unit where she has enjoyed bringing new life into the world as well as sharing her knowledge with staff and expectant parents.

Kim's work as an obstetrics nurse at GRMC provides unique insight into the needs of the unit. "As a member of the OB staff, having an additional labor and delivery room and updated postpartum rooms will be hugely beneficial," states Kim. "Having more space to provide care also gives us the ability to be more efficient when accessing supplies that will be more readily available in the new rooms."

Austin and Kim care deeply about Grinnell and the surrounding region. They put that caring into action in their work and in their philanthropy, adding to the Jones family's long history of supporting the hospital.

Generations of Giving

Austin's grandfather, F.A. Jones, was a member of the Community Hospital Board of Directors, serving as Treasurer from 1966 to 1968, during the time of its merger with St. Francis Hospital. He had the financial knowledge to keep Community Hospital from going under and ensure that Grinnell General Hospital was able to survive fiscally during its early years.

Marion Jones, Austin's mother, (at right with her husband, F. Addison Jones, in 2005) was a member of the Grinnell General Hospital Board of Directors. She was proud to be the board's first female Chairman, serving in that role from 1986 to 1988. During her tenure, she led the hospital through the transition of adding outpatient care services and dedicated the Mammography Unit in 1987 with First Lady Barbara Bush by her side. Initially her involvement was through the Community Hospital Auxiliary's various fund-raising efforts including membership drives, charity balls, and the gift shop.

"My mother, father, and grandfather all instilled in me the importance of a strong Hospital in our community," shares Austin.



The Grinnell State Bank was organized in 1925 by Grinnell businessmen to be an independent community bank and is still fulfilling that role today. The Jones Family has owned and operated the bank since 1954, and that legacy continues with a fifth generation of family members on staff. Grinnell State Bank has been a long-time supporter of GRMC, contributing to numerous capital campaigns (Moving at the Speed of Life, Blueprint for Health, Building on Excellence, 1983 Capital Fund Drive) and programs such as Anesthesia Medicine and Bike Helmets for Third Graders.

The bank's support of the *Delivering Our*Future campaign continues their history

of community involvement. "The
Hospital is probably one of the most
important economic engines for a
rural area," says Austin. "It brings
quality of Life, quality jobs, and
quality people that will make
for a great City, County, and
region."

NEW ENDOFLIP FOR SURGERY DEPARTMENT

Thanks to your donations, the GRMC Foundation was able to help GRMC's Surgery Department purchase a new EndoFLIP, a minimally invasive type of technology that can be used during endoscopy to measure dimensions, movement and pressure inside the esophagus and other organs.

BLADDER SCANNER FOR HOSPITAL

Because of your support, a new bladder scanner has been purchased for GRMC. Our nurses and patient care technicians recognized a need for a second scanner to expedite care for patients and, thanks to you, the GRMC Foundation was able to meet that need.

This new scanner harnesses real-world data to consistently detect and define bladder location, size and shape for all pediatric and adult patients. It measures the bladder volume within seconds and its simple charting tool easily transfers exam results to any electronic healthcare record system.

NEW MANOMETRY FOR SURGERY DEPARTMENT

This system is used to measure the muscles at the top and bottom of the esophagus, and also measures the pressure, speed, and wave pattern of muscle contractions along the esophagus while swallowing.

"This new equipment has made esophageal manometry easier for our technicians due to shorter procedure times which makes the procedure more tolerable for our patients," says Angie Oakie, RN, BSN, MHA, GRMC Surgery Department Manager.

GRMC EARNS LGBTQ+ HEALTHCARE EQUALITY LEADER DESIGNATION

GRMC, Iowa Methodist Medical Center, Iowa Lutheran Hospit Methodist West Hospital and Blank Children's Hospital were named five of the 384 healthcare facilities nationwide earning the LGBTQ+ Healthcare Equality Leader designation from the Human Rights Campaign Foundation (HRC). These designations were awarded in the 16th iteration of HRC's Healthcare Equality Index released on May 7, 2024. This is the first time GRMC has been recognized by HRC at Leader statu



BREAST CANCER CARE CLOSE TO HOME

In 2024, the hospital purchased a Neoprobe®. This imaging device is used by surgeons to pinpoint cancerous tissue during surgery to provide patients with a more precise and personalized approach to their breast cancer diagnosis and treatment. By offering this technology locally, patients can receive advanced care close to home, reducing stress and travel burdens.

"We are excited to be able to offer Neoprobe to our patients," says Dr. Anna Mensing, general and breast surgeon at UnityPoint Health - Grinnell General Surgery and Weight Loss Surgery Clinic (pictured at right). "This technology is a game-changer in breast cancer care, and we are committed to providing our community with the most advanced treatment options available."

GRMC LAUNCHES SELF-CHECK-IN KIOSKS

To make care easier and more efficient for patients, GRMC has rolled out a self-check-in kiosk. The new kiosk is located at the outpatient registration check-in area. The kiosks are intended to be the first stop for all patients who currently use outpatient registration for walk-in or scheduled appointments. Patients who have complex registration needs will be prompted to visit the registration desk and complete their check-in process.

Patients with appointments in departments that don't use outpatient registration, like Rehabilitation Services or Infusion and Chemotherapy, should continue following the same check-in process.



CENTER OF EXCELLENCE GRANT RENEWED

UnityPoint Health - Grinnell received a fourth round of grant funding in 2024 from the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services (previously Iowa Department of Public Health) as a **Center of Excellence in rural maternal health care**. We have been awarded \$215,500 to continue establishing Iowa's framework for access to high quality obstetric services for rural populations.

2024 GREAT IOWA NURSE

Kim Sears, RN, BSN, clinical education specialist and staff development coordinator was named to the prestigious list of 2024 Great Iowa Nurses. This award annually recognizes nurses at healthcar

A Groundbreaking Procedure at GRMC Impacts Many Lives

In the fall of 2024, a patient entered GRMC's emergency department with a life—threatening situation necessitating artificial life support. The GRMC care team, in partnership with the lowa Donor Network and the patient's family, began the work of fulfilling the patient's wishes for organ donation. Usually in these situations, patients are transferred to Des Moines for the organ harvest, but the family wanted the patient to remain in Grinnell.

In a groundbreaking procedure, our team, working closely with the Iowa Donor Network (IDN), ultimately performed the organ harvest here at GRMC - the first time ever at a rural Iowa hospital. The patient's kidneys and liver were flown immediately to three different locations for transplant, resulting in saving three recipients' lives. The heart valves, musculoskeletal tissue and skin tissue were harvested as well, impacting 75 lives.

In a letter from the Iowa Donor Network, chief executive officer Suzanne Conrad, RN, MS, states, "We appreciate the opportunity to work collaboratively with your staff to make donation a reality for the patient and their family."

However, we also have joy and a sense of accomplishment knowing that three people were gifted with life!"

Donor Bill of Rights

Philanthropy is based on voluntary action for the common good. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life. To assure philanthropy merits the respect and trust of the general public, and donors and prospective donors can have full confidence in the not-for-profit organizations and causes they are asked to support, we declare that all donors have these rights:

- 1. To be informed of the organization's mission, of the way the organization intends to use donated resources, and of its capacity to use donations effectively for intended purposes.
- 2. To be informed of the identity of those serving on the organization's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
- 3. To have access to the organization's most recent financial statements.
- 4. To be assured that their gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given.
- 5. To receive appropriate acknowledgment and recognition.
- 6. To be assured that information about their donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
- 7. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing organizations of interest to the donor will be professional in nature.
- 8. To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees of the organization, or hired solicitors.
- 9. To have the opportunity for their names to be deleted from mailing lists that an organization may intend to share.
- 10. To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful, and forthright answers.
