PUBLIC HEALTH IMPACT

Chlamydia and gonorrhea are two of the leading causes of preventable infertility. The Allen Women's Health service area had a total of 1,286 cases of chlamydia and gonorrhea in 2023. Syphilis is the fastest growing sexually transmitted infection in the state, with an 88% positivity increase from 2020 to 2023.

Other/No method

At AWH we have many patients who speak in different languages, so we offer **interpreters** to our patients at no extra cost to them.

AWH served patients in 10 languages other than English, including Spanish, Burmese, French and Haitian Creole.

FAMILY PLANNING BENEFITS

- Telehealth appointments continued to increase patient satisfaction and improve patient follow up.
- Confidential services offered for patients of any age.
- Peri- and post-menopausal care provided.
- All AWH patients receive mental health screening and basic medication management as appropriate.
- Funding offered for family planning services for uninsured patients.
