UnityPoint Health® – Jones Regional Medical Center Named Top 20 Critical Access Hospital in America

UnityPoint Health – Jones Regional Medical Center (JRMCC) has been recognized as one of the Top 20 Critical Access Hospitals in the United States by the National Rural Health Association (NRHA). This recognition places JRMCC in the top 1.5% of all 1,353 critical access hospitals nationwide and highlights JRMCC's ongoing commitment to delivering exceptional, patient-centered care.

The Top 20 designation is based on the Chartis Rural Hospital Performance INDEX, which evaluates hospitals on eight key performance areas: inpatient market share, outpatient market share, quality, outcomes, patient perspective, cost, charge, and finance. The hospitals selected were part of the Top 100 Critical Access Hospital list released earlier this year by the Chartis Center for Rural Health.

"We are humbled and honored to be recognized among the top 20 critical access hospitals in the nation. This award is a tribute to our incredible providers and dedicated team members who serve our community with compassion and excellence every day," said Eric Briesemeister, JRMCC CEO.

Critical access hospitals like JRMCC are essential to ensuring access to care in rural communities. In addition to celebrating this recognition, JRMCC continues to invest in its future with ongoing facility enhancements, including a new pharmacy drive-thru and a \$5 million expansion project to bring in-house MRI services to the hospital.

Whether it's financial hurdles like this one or helping our neighbors clean up after the derecho, we've always found a way through.

We didn't become a Top 20 Critical Access Hospital by luck. We got here by rolling up our sleeves, getting creative, and keeping our eyes on what matters most: taking care of each other. Around here, when there's a problem, we don't throw up our hands—we get to work. This challenge is no different. Thankfully, we've got a little breathing room. The cuts don't kick in for another two years, which gives us time to plan, prepare, and make smart choices. That's a gift, and we'll use it well.

One thing I want you to know: Jones Regional isn't going anywhere. We've been here through thick and thin, and we'll keep being here—day in and day out—when you need us most.

And here's where we could use your help. Keep telling your family, friends, and neighbors why keeping care local matters. Share your stories about how Jones Regional has touched your life. Every visit, every kind word, and every bit of trust you place in us makes us stronger.

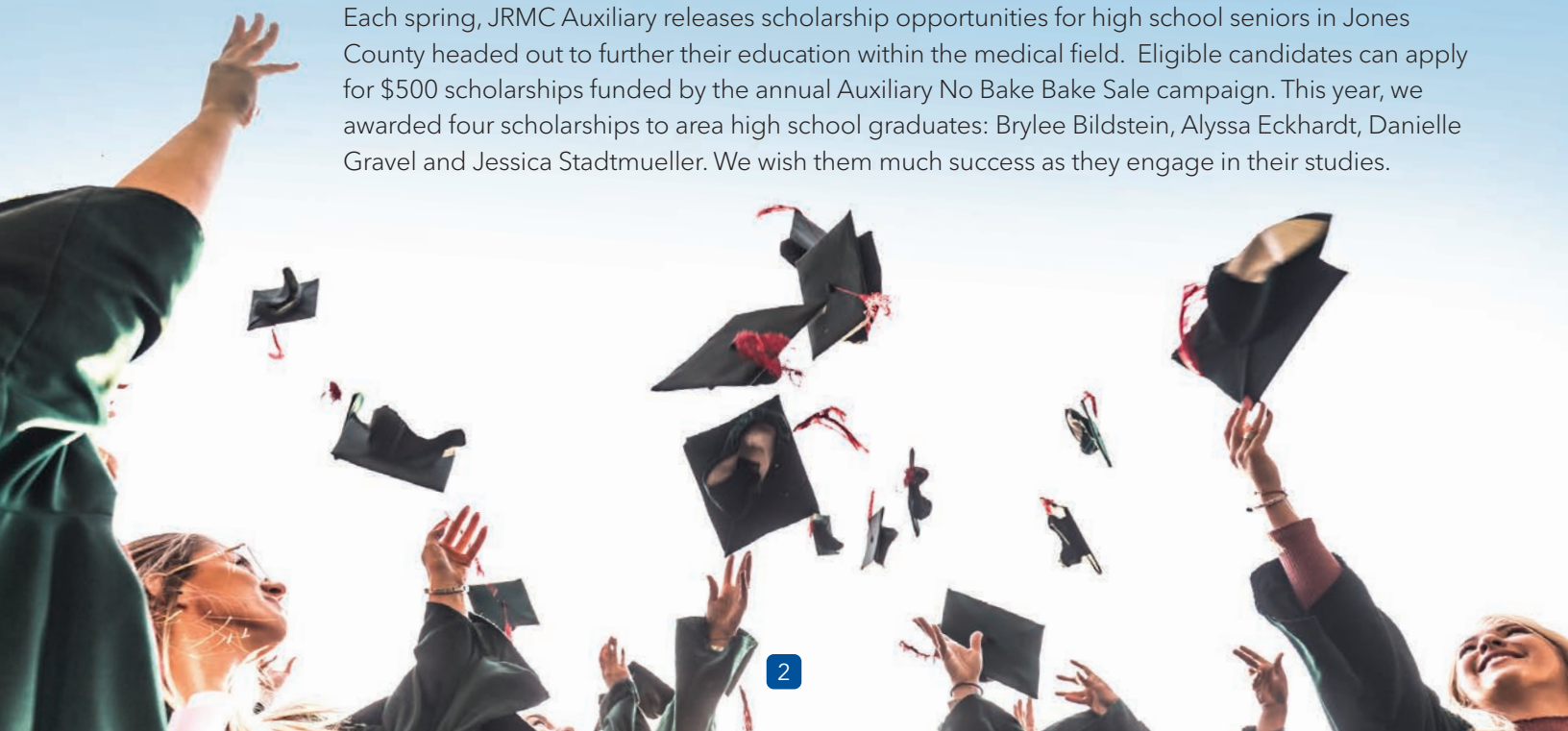
We're all in this together, and together we'll make sure Jones Regional stays strong for generations to come. That's just how we do things around here.

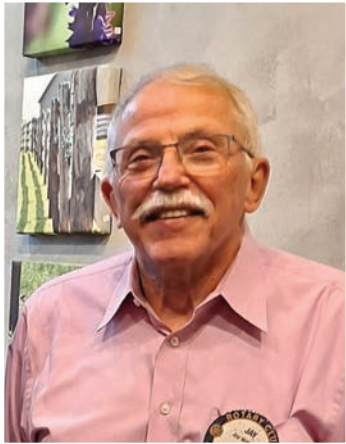

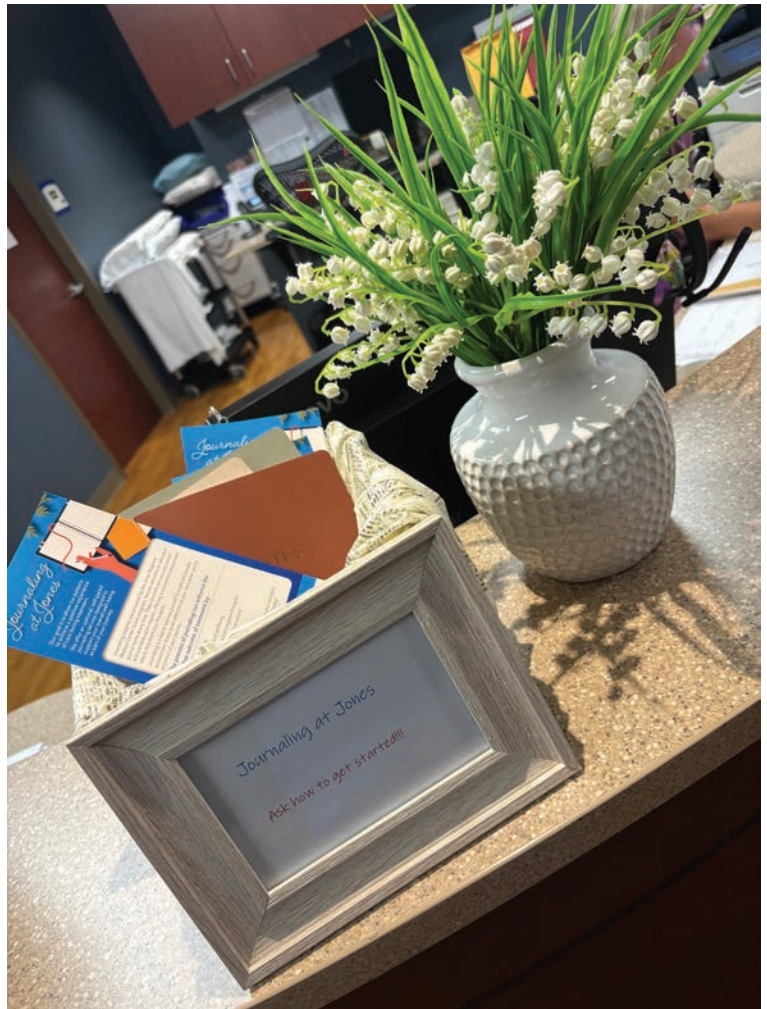
